Seems as if everybody dreams about being rich and famous. But rarely does anyone discuss the price of fame.

David Bowie had a pointed musical take on it.

"Fame puts you there where things are hollow," the Thin White Duke sang. "Fame, what you get is no tomorrow.... Could it be the best ...?"

Maybe not, but deep down inside it's what so many people want.

The mansions. The adoration. The klieg lights. The limos. The boats. The jets. The islands. Designer clothes. Expensive cars. White glove treatment. Being able to get anything you want with a smile or nod. From where most people stand, it all looks great.

Andy Warhol once said, in the future everyone will be famous for 15 minutes. Turns out, he was pretty close. In the age of social media, that concept has exploded.

It used to be that you had to have some kind of talent to become famous. You had to be a charismatic actor, a gifted athlete, or a talented musician. Now to get your 15 minutes of fame, all you have to do is something outrageous to get attention. Talent or charisma or ability is no longer any kind of determinant if you're famous or not. You can hold an American flag during a Florida hurricane. You can own a particularly ugly cat. You can stuff 75 hot dogs down your throat in 10 minutes or less. Or have a catchy nickname on a reality show and land national endorsement deals in the millions.

Have you ever heard of the "27 Club"?

It's an informal list of stars who died at that age. We're talking Brian Jones, Jimi Hendrix, Janis Joplin, Jim Morrison, Amy Winehouse, and Kurt Cobain.

Other well-known celebrities have taken their lives over the decades.

Marilyn Monroe. Ernest Hemingway. More recently, Anthony Bordain and Kate Spade.

All these people at one time or another had the world at their feet—and it wasn't fulfilling.

If fame and money were the answers, why did so many make such a heartbreaking choice?

Take it from those who have tried it all. Wealth and possessions won't give you that peace. There's no relationship with anyone, as wonderful as they may be, that will give you that peace.


Alcohol won't give you that peace. Drugs won't give you that peace. Philosophy and higher education won't give you that peace.


Yes, even "religion" won't give you that peace.








### 2. RECOGNIZE THAT JESUS CHRIST DIED ON THE CROSS FOR YOU.

#### 3. REPENT OF YOUR SIN.






#### 4. RECEIVE JESUS CHRIST INTO YOUR LIFE.

# MAKENNA KARMIE'S LEGACY HELPS MANY 'FIND HOPE'

To say that ForeverLawn is a family business is underselling it a little bit. In this northeast corner of Ohio, the Karmies are seemingly everywhere. Dale and Brian, brothers, partners, and leaders of this merry enterprise, have surrounded themselves with family, figuratively and literally. Their wives, daughters, and sons work alongside them in creating an organization that has flourished over the last decade.

The story is relatively unique.
Two brothers move from their
native Ohio to Albuquerque, New
Mexico, to go to a new business.
A couple of issues arose: they
had no money, experience, nor
connection to this new industry,
synthetic grass (some would call
it AstroTurf). Nonetheless, their
spirit of adventure and firm belief
in each other enables them to
build a thriving enterprise that
is flourishing today.

However, the Karmie journey would probably be a fairly typical

American success story—if not for their daughter Makenna's tragic passing at the age of 20. Referred to as the "hub" of wherever she went, school, work, or church, this full-of-energy young woman was just at the start of a very vibrant life when the Lord called her up to Heaven. It's not every day that someone has a personal connection with Harvest Ministries from Ohio, but Makenna and her family had followed Pastor Greg Laurie's teaching, and one of her wishes was to come to a Harvest Church service, which she got to do shortly before her untimely death. After her funeral, the Karmies came back to California to follow up on their daughter's wishes and introduced them to Pastor Greg -who mentioned them during the service.

To say that they were honored and humbled by this gesture is an understatement. From that moment on, Dale and his family tried to find a way to give a measure of thanks to Harvest. And as it happened, their company started to sponsor the NASCAR "0" car driven by Jeff Earnhardt (grandson of legend Dale Earnhardt) and without asking for anything in return they started displaying the Harvest logo on the bumper of the car, along with a simple message: "Find Hope." As Dale would say: "This was the least we could do to promote His kingdom and honor Makenna's legacy."

Makenna Karmie will never be forgotten, and neither is a growing company in the heartland of America. This unique family's story is proof positive that God is at work through the good and the bad, and His love and power of redemption never fail.



#### LANCE CORPORAL KAREEM NIKOUI

was the burgeoning pride of his family: a young man who understood what commitment, honor, and integrity meant. In addition, or perhaps because he had it, his faith gave him courage and peace beyond our understanding.

Kareem was one of 13 brave young Americans who gave their lives in the service of others in a distant land, far from his family and friends. His last act on this Earth was to help people escape from what was threatening to be a perilous situation.

He paid the ultimate price, and though he and his fellow soldiers are more than deserving of our accolades and honor, we know that Kareem's ultimate reward is the one he received in Heaven when he heard, "Well done, good and faithful servant" (Matthew 25:21).

During the SoCal Harvest in 2016, Kareem, who had accompanied his parents to Angel Stadium, gave his life to Christ and embarked on his journey of faith. As his father said, "That's the only thing that mattered to me, him coming to Jesus, nothing else mattered, I was so proud of that moment." Speaking during his memorial at Harvest Riverside, Pastor Greg

Laurie said, "The motto of the Marine Corps is *Semper Fi*. It means 'Always Faithful.' Kareem was both faithful and full of faith in Christ."

At this year's SoCal Harvest—you may find others just like Kareem taking their first steps toward the ultimate reward: eternity with their Father in Heaven.



I think we're all very aware of the fact that our world is in turmoil right now.

There's a sense of fear in the air, due in part to this global pandemic that was supposed to have come and gone but just seems to keep going with new strains and no real end in sight. Meanwhile, our cities here in the United States are in turmoil, with violence and murder rates rising dramatically.

Two years ago I gave my life to Christ here at Harvest. It was the best decision I could have ever made!!




